Ownership of the Personal Data

To enable the Covid-19 testing to be completed at Bromsgrove School, we need to process personal data for staff and pupils taking part, including sharing of personal data where we have a legal obligation. Bromsgrove School is the Data Controller for the data required for processing the tests and undertaking any actions which are needed by the school / college to ensure we meet our public health and safeguarding legal obligations.

Personal data relating to tests for pupils is processed under article 6 (1) (e) of the UK GDPR (public task). Paragraph 7 of the Schedule to the Education (Independent School Standards) Regulations 2014 is also relevant.

Personal data relating to staff is processed under the legitimate interest of data controller to ensure we can minimise the spread of COVID in a timely manner and enable us to continue to deliver education services safely and securely.
